The AMF and the ACP warn investors about the business activities of several unauthorised websites and entities offering forex investments

The Autorité de contrôle prudentiel (ACP) and the Autorité des marchés financiers (AMF) have published an updated list of unauthorised website and entities in France offering investments in the unregulated currency (or forex) market. This news release is the fifth warning issued by the AMF and the ACP since 7 July 2011¹.
