Central Bank of Ireland Issues Warning on Investment Firm

The Central Bank of Ireland ("Central Bank") today (1 February 2013) published the

name of an unauthorised investment firm. Pendulum Capital Markets Inc. (USA)

has been offering investment services to members of the Irish public and is not

authorised as an investment firm in Ireland.

A list of unauthorised firms published to date is available on the Central Bank website.

It is a criminal offence for an investment firm to operate in Ireland unless it has an

authorisation from the Central Bank. Consumers should be aware that, if they deal with

an investment firm which is not authorised, they are not eligible for compensation from

the Investor Compensation Scheme.

Any person wishing to contact the Central Bank with information regarding such firms

may telephone (01) 224 4000. This line is also available to the public to check if an

investment firm is authorised. Since obtaining the necessary legal powers in August

1998, the names of 201 unauthorised firms have been published by the Central Bank.
