

WARNING NOTIFICATION FOR INVESTORS

(Vienna, 3 February 2007)

Pursuant to section 4 para 7 of the *Bankwesengesetz* (BWG; Austrian Banking Act), Austria's Financial Market Authority (FMA) has the right – by way of publication in the official gazette "Amtsblatt zur Wiener Zeitung" or any other official bulletin with nationwide circulation – to inform the general public of the fact that a particular company is not allowed to carry out certain banking activities (section 1 para 1 no. 1 BWG (deposit business) and section 1 para 1 no. 3 BWG (credit business)).

By publication in the official gazette "Amtsblatt zur Wiener Zeitung" of 3 February 2007 the FMA is exercising this right and warns against doing business with the following provider:

This provider does not possess a licence issued by the FMA. Therefore, it is neither allowed to accept customers' funds for management purposes or as deposit nor to conclude loan agreements and grant loans.
