Kredittilsynet has been informed that The Sherwood Corporation (address: Shinjuku Monolith Bldg. 2-3-1 Nishi-Shinjuku-Shinjuku-ku, 163-0907 Tokyo, Japan and 210 E Capitol St, Jackson, MS 39201 USA) has contacted Norwegian investors and tried to purchase shares. In return, the investors must, among other things, pay a fee in advance in order to receive the purchase price. The company also offers services from the website www.sherwood-corp.com.

Kredittilsynet informs that The Sherwood Corporation has not received any approval to perform investment services in Norway, involving that the company does not have necessary authorisation in accordance with Norwegian law. This also involves that Kredittilsynet does not supervise the company and has not approved the services offered by the company. Kredittilsynet therefore recommends that investors do not enter into agreements or transfer values to The Sherwood Corporation.

Kredittilsynet's registry contains information on all companies which are authorized to offer investment services in Norway. A list (not complete), of parties in the market which operate without approval, can also be found on Kredittilsynet's website.
